We take the opportunity of the 60th anniversary of the school to expand our research field and organize a series of workshops at the Lecoq Lees studio.

The studio, imagined by Fay Lees and Jacques Lecoq in the nineteen's, develops different creative activities linked to the school's pedagogy and the LEM (Laboratory for the study of movement – department of scenography of the school).

At only one hour distance of Paris, located in the Vexin countryside, this space regularly welcomes in residence companies such as: Footsbarn theatre, GRRR company (Susana Lastreto), Remote control, Manifesto Poetico.

These workshops bring together theatre and plastic arts. Taking into account today's cultural context valorising creative interaction, we propose a total immersion experience in the form of full-time workshops.







THE WORKSHOPS

Passions, Characters and Situations

17th to 21st of July 2017

With Pascale Lecog, François Lecog and Carlos García Estévez

This workshop proposes an encounter between play and its plastic transposition. It concerns young artists whatever their artistic discipline may be. (theatre, graphic arts, writing...). We will explore human passions as a driving force for the actor, going through mimo-dynamics and plastic transpositions: drawing, constructions, etc...

Experience and understanding the space in which passions evolve permits to imagine the characters.

Our approach includes:

- Physical preparation and movement analysis
- Improvisation
- Awareness of play in a given space / space constraints
- Creation of costumes (shapes, colours...)

This workshop is given in French.
Possibility of translation into English, Spanish and Italian.

Tariff: 850 euros/ 6 hours a day, including food and accomodation.
